What are some causes of constant screaming parrots?

If your parrot is constantly screaming, there may be many factors that may cause your parrot to scream the most common causes are listed below:

- A problem with the cage or environment they are in, such as nothing for them to play with, you must keep your parrot stimulated, chewing on natural branches or wooden toys.
- Not a big enough area for them to stretch their wings or something threatening their environment, parrots do need exercise if your bird is going to live in a caged environment the environment must be big enough for them for adequate exercise this should include jumping from perch to perch and flight.
- It may be that the bird is seeking attention, if the parrot has been spoiled with too much love and attention all the time and then it stops, they can become frustrated, upset and screaming sometimes gets your attention back to them.
- Parrots that have not been trained and disciplined accordingly may feel they are in charge and scream to show their importance and to intimidate their human owners.
- If a bird is bored with their environment with nothing new to play with or not enough time out of their cage they can scream to gain your attention or to just simply occupy themselves, it is a good rule of thumb to rotate bird toys, try some different things even an old toilet roll can work.
- During breeding periods birds can be triggered into mating rituals, which may cause them to scream out for a mate.
